

Claim Management Regarding Nutritional/Caloric Agents in MississippiCAN

Nutritional/Caloric Agents Filed as Pharmacy Claim

- Effective 1/1/2015 nutritional products identified on the Mississippi Division of Medicaid (MS-DOM) Preferred Drug List (PDL) should be billed as pharmacy claims. Access the MS-DOM PDL at: <http://www.medicaid.ms.gov/providers/pharmacy/>
- Providers must be enrolled as a participating provider in OptumRx's MississippiCAN retail network and follow standard Point of Service claim filing procedures. For enrollment, call OptumRx at 877-305-8952.

Nutritional/Caloric Agents Filed as Medical Claim

- Nutritional products not represented on the Mississippi PDL may be considered for reimbursement as a medical claim.
- All nutritional products provided to members as a medical service must be prior authorized. Call UnitedHealthcare prior authorization review at: 866-604-3267.
- Several of the standard HCPC codes for nutritional items are listed as non-covered codes on the MS-DOM fee schedule. The MS-DOM fee schedule can be accessed at the following link: <https://www.ms-medicaid.com/msenvision/feeScheduleInquiry.do>
- In order to file nutritional items as MSCAN medical claims to UHC, providers should utilize B9998 (enteral) or B9999 (parenteral) only.
- All other correct coding rules as established by CMS, AMA, and other industry standards apply.
- In order to manually price nutritional items as a medical claim, NDC and invoice/MSRP must be submitted in compliance with MS-DOM Administrative Code Part 209 guidelines on manual pricing methodology.  - Invoice/MSRP must be submitted to support claim pricing
 - Pricing rules currently established by MS-DOM:
 - Invoice plus 20%
 - MSRP minus 20%
